What I do not offer:

- To say yes to all requests;

What you need to consider:

- The purposes for which you need the images;
- Whether a press or professional photographer might be more suitable;
- Whether consent in advance for photography needs to be obtained from your participants (or parents / guardians, if appropriate);
- Whether a DBS check is needed;
- Whether or not you need permission from anyone else to invite me;
- How I am to gain entry to the setting.
