### **Standards Updates and Formal Interpretations: NZS 4512 & NZS 4541**

Good progress is being made in finalising the scope and dates for the update of NZS 4503. This standard, last published in 2005, is particularly important to our HOFFE members and is overdue for revision. We also have several committee members involved in the FPO03 project, which directly affects parts of NZS 4503. Further updates will be shared as they become available.

Many of you are aware that the formal process for requesting clarifications on these standards has been inactive for over a year. Given the technical complexity of our standards, it is essential that this process is reinstated. We have been in discussions with Standards NZ and MBIE to address this, and I hope to announce a resolution in the coming weeks. Please be assured that we are actively working to restore this important process for the industry.

### **Council updates**

I would also like to thank the following FPANZ Council members for their service: Nicky Marshall, Garth Moran, Ben Bakker, and Phil Lacey. While Nicky and Phil are seeking re-election, the others have completed their terms and will be standing down at the end of the AGM on the 27th. Please join me in expressing our gratitude for their dedication and for representing our members in their various Council roles. All newly appointed council positions will be announced to members next week.

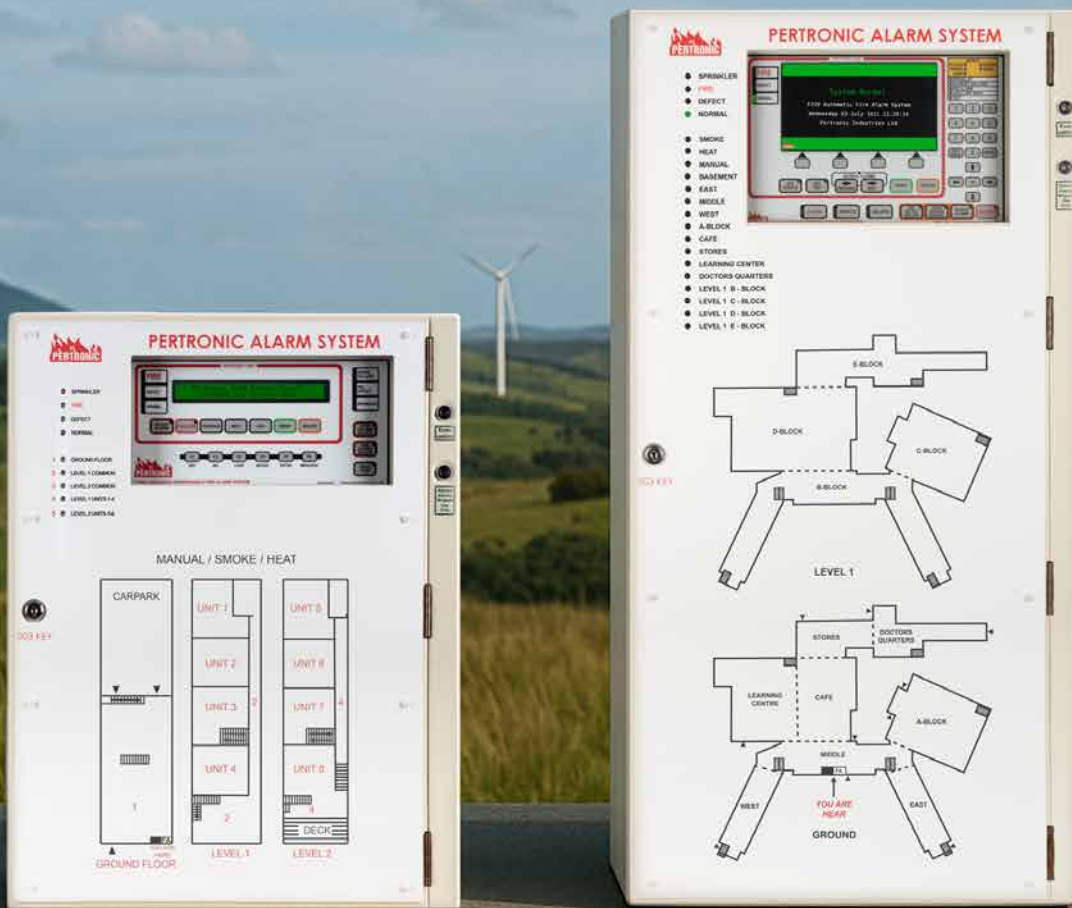

## HOFFE SIG Update

It might sound cliché but this year has gone so quick, now we are running out of sport and having to think about Santa, yeah right!!!

Back onto the fire stuff, we found ourselves in a bizarre position the other day looking at a fire extinguisher that was classed as a water type claiming compliance with AS/NZS 1841.2 (water type) yet printed on the cylinder was a claimed rating of 3A:10B:D? It also had a disclaimer printed on the side of the cylinder stating that the D rating only applied to Lithium-Ion? Lithium is class D but not Lithium-Ion as it is not catered for by the AS/NZS standards?

Unfortunately, it didn't end there as they also had the 365gram "magic sticks" on offer which claim the product is "Certified for Fire Classes: A, B, C, E and F." Further to this these devices claim a rating of 2B:1C1F (printed on them and supporting material) there is even a blazon sign available with these classes of fire printed on it?

As many of you will be aware under the AS/NZS standards it states, "The minimum B rating for portable fire extinguishers shall be "2B" for carbon dioxide type; and "5B" for extinguishers other than carbon dioxide type."

A check on the Australian distributor's website finds claims like "C and F tested and passed to AS/NZS1850 in compliance with AS/NZS1841". At best these claims are misleading, also of concern were the videos which showed the operator going right up to the fire with the 365gram device to extinguish it, this is risky and not a practice we would recommend.

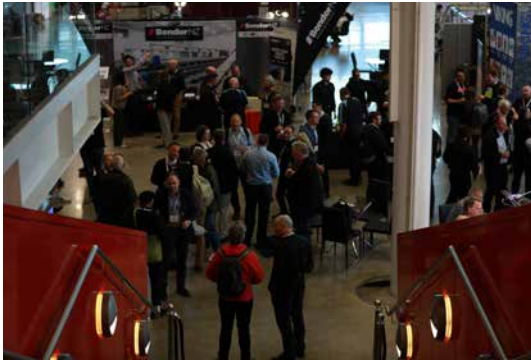

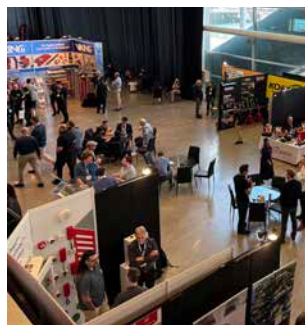
